

CAMPERSHIP APPLICATION 2019

To apply for Temple funding, please complete the form below and submit it **no later than March 18, 2019** to:

If additional funding is needed, we recommend you contact the camp directly.

Campership funds come from the proceeds of the annual Hamantashen/ Purim Carnival project. To receive a campership for your child, parents are required to participate in at least one baking session, if requesting for more than 1 child, at least 2 baking sessions AND volunteer a minimum of 6 hours; at least 3 hours at the Carnival on Sunday, March 17, 2019 and at least 3 hours for the Torah School (Purim or Non-Purim related), i.e. Shabbat dinners, etc. Families of Campership recipients are expected to do their best to SELL (not buy) 10 dozen Hamantashen per number of camperships requested.

The committee to allocate the available funds and to choose the recipients for the Camperships shall be made up of the following people: **Rabbis, Youth Group Advisors, Temple President and Executive Director.** No parent with a child applying for a campership shall serve on this committee.

The Temple Board has approved the following guidelines for distribution of Campership funds:

1. A Campership is given for **financial need and for merit which is interpreted as interest and participation.**
2. The youth must make a **commitment to continue his/her Jewish education through Kabbalat Torah/ Confirmation.**
3. **The youth will have to sign a commitment to continue active participation in OYE, EASY or SanETY Temple youth groups.** Younger children will be required to have regular attendance at Torah School and Family Shabbat.
4. The parent(s) must be members in good standing in the congregation. Dues and all other financial obligations to the Temple must be current upon application for Campership.
5. The Youth Committee of Temple Emanu-El endorses for receipt of Camperships for any accredited Jewish Camp.
